If a swimming pool is included in the initial landscape, 90% of the front landscape must be completed within 90 days of close of escrow. A 10' (ten foot) access is allowed for pool construction.					
Mounds cannot exceed 18" (eighteen inches) in height.					
Trash cans must not be visible from the street or neighboring property.					
If there is an irrigation box, the location must be noted on the plan and it must be opposite the swale from the foundation of the house.					
Storage facilities/structures must not be visible from street or neighboring property.					
Satellite dishes must be painted the color of the body of the house.					
IMPORTANT: Any change to the original approved plans made during construction must be presented to the ALC before implementation. Small plants are excluded.
